CPAC Process Learning Prioritizing Recommending




Purpose & Process

- At the end of tonight's meeting, the goal is to have a clear majority opinion on a recommendation for 3 different investment levels:
 - \$215 220M Base Case Scenario
 - \$250M
 - -\$265 280M
- Process: Seek consensus, if possible, via a series of votes to:
 - 1. Confirm priority 1 items
 - 2. Prioritize investment envelopes within capacity and then within QLE
 - 3. Prioritize combined investment envelopes across capacity and QLE

Includes Preliminary Maintenance "Base Package" of ~\$220M






Map of Priority 1 New & Additional Capacity Investments

- 1. Members will receive 3 dots to vote
- 2. Each dot will be worth one vote
- 3. The color of the dot does not matter, they are all the same vote
- 4. Members can only vote for a project once in this round
- 5. Members may only invest up to \$10M in funding. I.e. you would only use "one dot" if you voted for Place Bridge Academy
- 6. The projects with the highest number of votes will be included



- 2. Members will receive dots to vote
- 3. Each dot will be worth one vote
- 4. The color of the dot does not matter, they are all the same vote
- 5. Members can only vote for a project once in this round
- 6. Members may only invest up to \$15M in funding above the investments from envelope #2
- 7. The projects with the highest number of votes will be included
