

HIGH TECH EARLY COLLEGE

School Overview

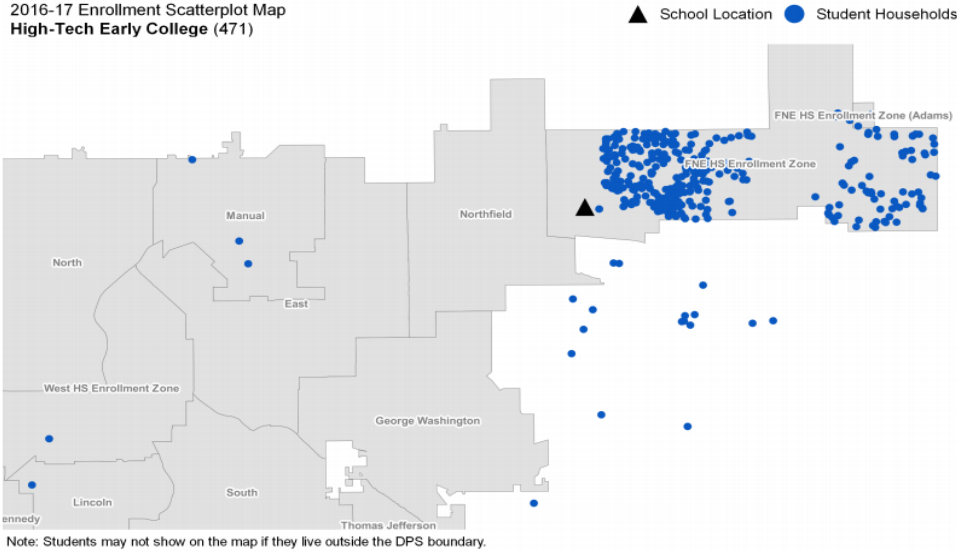
- High Tech Early College (HTEC) is a district-managed Innovation high school in the Far Northeast (FNE) enrollment zone
- School program focuses on preparing students for college and a 21st Century Global Economy through applied learning and intense connections with business and industry
 - HTEC students participate in FNE regional athletics and activities
- Approximately 400 students projected to enroll for 2017-18, with over 75% of students qualifying for free-and-reduced lunch
- HTEC is a hub school for DPS CareerConnect program (more information on this program appended), and was just recently designated by the state as an Early College high school
 - Currently offer Computer Science and Robotics, Digital Design, Audio Engineering, and Business Pathways through CareerConnect with 95% of students participating in CareerConnect Pathways (2nd highest participation rate in District)
 - School selected as a pilot school for the new Career Residency program
 - The early college model allows students to take free college-level courses while in high school, and creates an intentional pathway to a college degree. Designed to expose students to college at a younger age, students can begin taking early college courses as early as ninth grade and graduate high school with as many as 60 credits – or an associate’s degree – tuition free.
- School was selected for 2016 Bond facility investments (adding science labs & outdoor recreation)
- 2015-16 school SPF score was Yellow/Accredited on Watch (AoW)
 - School met performance indicators for Student Growth and Equity

- Just over half of HTEC students live within 2 miles of the facility; over 80% live within 5 miles

- Majority of students use DPS Success Express for transportation to/from school
- Success Express is a fleet of DPS buses that circulate through the Far Northeast neighborhood offering students multiple opportunities to catch a ride
